MOVE OUT CLEANING CHECKLIST FOR THE RETURN OF THE SECURITY DEPOSIT

KITCHEN
Clean Refrigerator: shelves, crisper drawers, under drawers and foot guard
Cupboards, counters, under sink, tile, exhaust fan and faucets
Stove, under burners, drip pans, knobs and rings
Oven, clean with an oven cleaner like Easy Off
Floors, sweep and mop
LIVING AND DINING ROOM
Baseboards wiped down, wipe down all light switches
Wipe down all window sills and blinds
Sweep and mop or vacuum floor
BEDROOMS
Same as living room
Empty all closets
BATHROOMS
Tub, shower, toilet, tank, sink and counters must all be cleaned
Wipe down mirrors and faucets
Sweep and mop floor
PORCH OR PATIO
Remove all refuse and sweep
